The 15th <u>International Congress of Immunology</u> meeting will be held in Milan, Italy from August 22 - 27, 2013. The CSI will once again sponsor students, post docs and junior investigators to attend this meeting. A junior investigator is defined as holding an Assistant Professor position for 5 years or less.

There will be 10 trainee awards @ \$1,500 each and 2 junior investigator awards @ \$2,500 each.

To be eligible for an award, the **student** or **post doc** must be a member of the CSI, as must be their supervisor (unless the supervisor's lab is not in Canada) for at least 2012 and 2013. Student or post doc travel award applicants must complete an online travel award application, including an abstract that will be submitted to the 15th International Congress in Immunology on which they are either first or senior author and have their supervisor send a letter of support by **December 18/12**. Visit the <u>CSI Website</u> for more information on how to apply.

To be eligible for an award as a **junior investigator**, applicants must be a member of the CSI for at least 2012 and 2013. Junior investigator travel award applicants must complete an application, include an abstract that will be submitted to the 15th International Congress of Immunology on which they are either first or senior author, include a one-page research statement and a copy of their most significant manuscript. The completed application deadline is by **December 18/12**. Visit the <u>CSI Website</u> for more information on how to apply.

A lab can only receive one award. The deadline for applying for an award is **December 18/12**. You will be notified of your success by <u>January 25/13</u>, allowing plenty of time to submit your abstract and make travel arrangements.

These 12 travel awards come from interest obtained from a fund generated when the International Congress was held in Canada (1986 and 2003).
