ICI 2019 - CSI Travel Award Applications Now Being Accepted

The [17th International Congress of Immunology](#) 2019 meeting will be held in Beijing, China from October 19 - 23, 2019. CSI will once again sponsor students, post docs and junior investigators to attend this meeting. A junior investigator is defined as within 6 years of their first faculty appointment.

There will be up to eleven trainee awards @ \$1,500 each and two junior investigator awards @ \$2,500 each. To be eligible for an award, the student or post doc must be a member of the CSI, as must be their supervisor (unless the supervisor's lab is not in Canada) for at least 2018 and 2019. Student or post doc travel award applicants must complete an online travel award application, including an abstract that has been submitted to the ICI 2019 meeting on which they are either first or senior author and have their supervisor send a letter of support by **Feb 15/19**. These travel awards come from interest obtained from a fund generated when the International Congress was held in Canada (1986 and 2003). We hope Canada will be well represented at the Congress.
