Dr. Rojas is an immunologist focusing on the role of immune cells in neuroinflammation. Currently, Dr. Rojas lab is interested in understanding the role of mucosal immune cells as a key intermediate of the gut-brain axis. Central to this question is understanding how B cells can directly (by migration) or indirectly (by cytokines, chemokines) impact neuroinflammation. Her main goal is to uncover the role of B cells and Plasma cells in the different compartments of the central nervous system

in health and disease.
