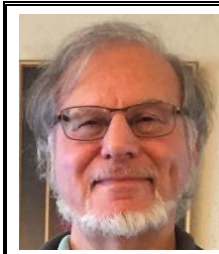

Dr. Wang is an emerging leader in Immunometabolism in Neuroinflammation and currently a Tier 2 Canada Research Chair holder. The Wang lab leverages systems and cell biology approaches to investigate how metabolic circuitry supports immune cell function in the context of brain health; and strives to understand the cell-cell interactions underlying the hypothalamus-pituitary-adrenal axis and its regulation of psychological and physical stress.
